How to Measure

Width: Awnings should extend past the glass 10" to 12" on each side. Awnings are made the width you need, just go to next higher price on the chart above.

Drop: Select an adequate mounting point 3" to 5" above the window on the trim or siding. Measure down from that point to 6" below 1/2 the height of the window. Select the drop closest to your measurement. Show the customer the amount of drop they will be getting!
